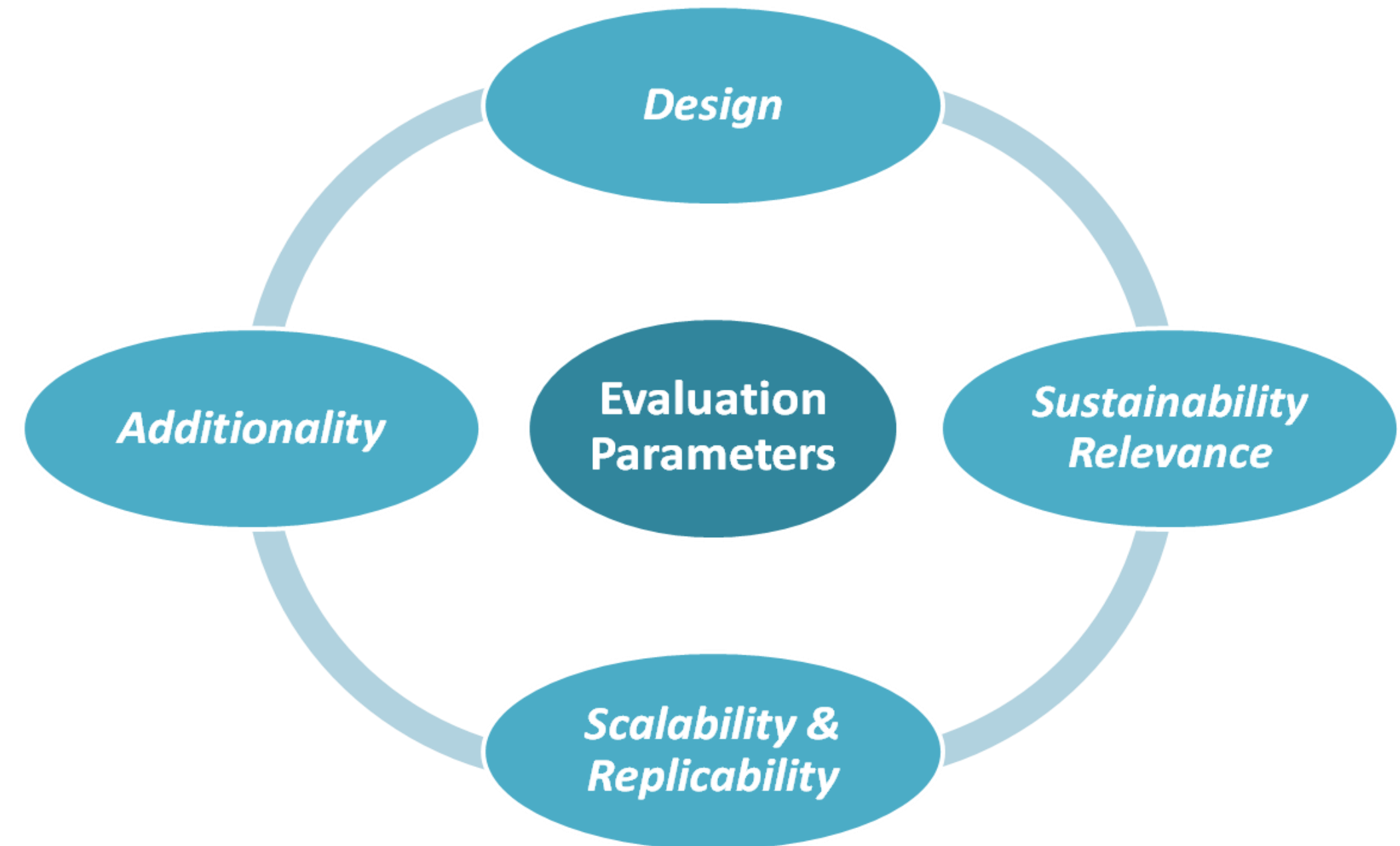

OVERVIEW

- To recognize innovative practices those are scalable and replicable across industry verticals.
- The organization may not be high on maturity w.r.t. Sustainability 4.0 Model, but doing exemplary work on sustainability through such innovative practices.
- All submitted applications are shortlisted by F&S-TERI team
- Only philanthropic initiatives under CSR mandate are not eligible. Interventions under a company's CSR mandate submitted for consideration are eligible only if they exhibit company efforts in designing interventions that are regularly monitored, verified and evaluated for effectiveness
- CSR programs submitted should be on project-mode initiated not before 1st April 2016. Such initiatives should showcase demonstrable socio-environmental impacts
